Shared Leadership will help you gain a better understanding of the people, various functions, and overall operation of the University!

Program Purpose

Shared Leadership provides Boise State University faculty and staff with the information they need to become active participants in the University. By combining practical leadership tools with an in-depth view of the university's processes, Shared Leadership will equip participants with the means necessary to make a significant contribution to the campus community and their individual departments.



What Can I Expect from Shared Leadership

In Shared Leadership, participants can expect to:

- Combine practical leadership tools with a corresponding campus/community activity or speaker in every session.
- Provide participants a number of opportunities to take part as leaders, in either a real or hypothetical situation.
- Foster an atmosphere of collaboration and enjoyment so that partnerships and friendships may be established and an exchange of leadership experiences may take place.
- Make available an opportunity for participants to learn leadership skills and styles from a mentor inside or outside the campus community.

Two-Year Time Commitment

Shared Leadership requires a two-year commitment. The first year participants devote one day per month from September through May (excludes December) to take part in the Shared Leadership program agenda. The second year, participants themselves will be designing and implementing the program for the following year's participants. Individual time commitment in the second year averages on-half day to one day per month, dependent upon committee involvement. Program Coordinators work in small groups to develop at least one monthly training session.



Who Can Apply

Participants must meet the following criteria to apply:

- Hold a 20+ hour/week permanent position at Boise State University
- Have the interest and intent to continue as a Boise State University employee for the next two years
- Share a commitment to Boise State University
- Receive supervisor's approval, and
- Commit to participation this year (2011-2012) and help plan and produce the following year's (2012-2013) program.

Applications and nominations are solicited from classified staff, faculty, and professional staff.
